We discourage children below Year 6 from fasting on school days; we appreciate and respect the fact that they sometimes want to take part, but in our experience, very young children who are fasting find it difficult to focus during the day. Please also note that if children who are fasting start to feel unwell, we will encourage them to have something to eat and drink.
