

Christmas Fayre

We really hope you'll be coming along to our Christmas Fayre on Wednesday. It starts at 3.30pm and we will have games and challenges to have a go at, food and drinks, a tombola, personalised calendars and more. As usual, we have managed to arrange for Father Christmas to set up his grotto in our school and you will be able to buy tickets to see him. More details of that below.

Raffle

We also have a fantastic raffle, with amazing prizes, including an Apple watch, a bike, afternoon tea for two at the Ramada Hotel and much, much more! Tickets are priced at £2 for a strip of 5 and they can be purchased at the fayre, or beforehand from the school office. Weather permitting, we will also be outside after school next week to sell tickets. The draw for the raffle will be made at 4.45pm approx. during the fayre. If you are not there to choose a prize, the first prize will be the Apple watch, the second prize will be the bike and the tea for two will be the third prize - but if you are there, you can choose whatever you want from what's available.

Santa's Grotto

As we did last year, we are selling tickets in advance for specific time slots. Visits to the grotto are charged at £2.50 each, and every paying visitor gets a present from Father Christmas. Tickets are on sale from the office and, weather permitting, we will be outside at the end of the day selling tickets in the run up to the fayre. Any remaining tickets will be on sale during the fayre itself.

Non-Uniform Days

We have further non-uniform days coming up. The first one is next Wednesday, and we are not asking for any donations - it's just because the Christmas Fayre is that day and it would be nice for children to be able to wear something Christmassy if they wish. Then, we will have a Christmas jumper day on Friday 14th December in aid of Save the Children; we are asking for a minimum £1 donation. Of course, children don't have to wear Christmas jumpers if they don't want to or don't have one; general non-uniform is fine.

Last Day of Term

The last day of term is Friday 21st December, and we are giving you the option of collecting your child early. A separate letter will follow. School will be open until 3.20pm so don't worry if you can't collect your child early.
