

Internet Safety

We have been alerted to a particular Internet safety issue that may have been affecting children recently. Various news outlets are now reporting that this was a hoax, but it is a timely reminder to us all, as school staff and as parents, to be extremely vigilant about our children's use of technology. Next week, we will be talking to children about threats in general, and the key message we will give them is that if they feel uncomfortable about anything, they should always tell a grown-up - either a parent or a member of school staff or preferably both. A key aspect of this is for them to have the confidence, as with all aspects of their own safety, if they are told that they mustn't tell anyone, they should ignore that and they should always tell. Please talk to your child regularly about these issues, as we will continue to do, please be vigilant and please come and talk to us if you have any questions or concerns. World Book Day
