Short Term Behaviour Strategy

Following our letter last Wednesday, we started our short term strategy this week. Hopefully you will recall that the strategy is aimed at reducing argumentative, defiant behaviour that has started to creep in among some of our children. As with all aspects of children's school life, it is tremendously beneficial when children see school and parents working together, and that is why part of this strategy includes sending a text message home when there is an incident of this nature. A few parents have asked for further details when they have received a text message this week. It is not practical to provide details of each incident, and one incident in isolation is not something that we would call you to discuss. All we ask is that you have a little chat with your child, tell them you are aware that there has been an incident and remind them of your expectation. If this develops into a pattern and you are receiving numerous text messages about it, we will call you in for a discussion. Thank you as always for your support. We are already seeing improvements from this strategy.

School Gate and Main Entrance

Parents should not be pressing the buzzer at the vehicle gate at any time, unless you have a prior arrangement with the school. Likewise, at the start of the day and at home time, all parents should come through the side gate and along the playgrounds to collect your children. Other than by prior arrangement, you should not be using the main entrance at these times. If you need to come to the office during the school day, then you should come via the main entrance, but you should park your car off the school site and walk up. Thank you for your co-operation.

Last Day of Term

The last day of the current term is Friday 12th April, and we are offering an optional early finish that day. If you wish to, you can collect your child any time from 1.15pm. Don't worry if you can't make it early - school will be open until 3.20pm for those who can't be collected. If you have a child in Year 5 or Year 6 and you want them to go home alone at 1.15pm, please put this in writing to their teacher.

A reminder that we are holding an Easter egg competition on Thursday 11th April. Just so there isn't any confusion, please note this is not the last day of term. There will be a prize for every entry with some star prizes in each year group. To enter, all you need to do is bring in a decorated egg.
