We are very grateful to those parents we have had to contact when their children have been unwell. Parents have got here quickly and taken their children for a Covid test. We can only go by the guidance we are given by the DfE and Birmingham City Council, and if your child or a member of the household has symptoms, your child must stay at home. reminder that the symptoms we are looking for are:

- A new, persistent cough
- A high temperature (37.8° or higher)

• A loss of taste and/or smell **COLLECTING CHILDREN**

It is vital that you have arrangements in place so that someone can collect your child quickly if you are called. We are sorry for any inconvenience caused, and we will only ask you to come if it is necessary. Please make sure that, every day, there is someone who can come for your child at short notice if you are called. Thank you.
