READING - THE ANCHOR TO LEARNING

LATERAL FLOW TESTS

Please note that if your child is asked to self-isolate and get a Covid-19 test, this must be a PCR test (usually carried out at a test centre). A lateral flow test does not have the same level of accuracy as a PCR test, so your child will not be allowed to return on the basis of a lateral flow test. Thank you for your co-operation.

FACE MASKS

Thank you for the overwhelming support we have had from you in wearing face masks on site. We have been taking spare masks out for those that need them, but after next week, we will stop doing this. Please bring your own - if you don't have one, unless you have let us know you are exempt, you will have to wait until everyone else has gone before you can collect your child.
