


### EID UL-FITR

- We will remain closed on Friday afternoons up to and including 18th June. If the government does ease restrictions as planned on 21st June, we intend to reopen on Friday afternoons starting on 25th June.

- The one way system and staggered start and finish times remain in place.
- Year 4 will no longer queue in the mornings they will be allowed in as they arrive. Please don't arrive too early; lessons will start at 9.00am for Year 4.
- Children will be staying in year group bubbles. Thank you for your continued support. It's fair to say we've all had enough, but it was clear from the survey responses that you recognise the importance of continuing to keep measures in place for everyone's safety.
