

PARKING AND TRAFFIC

Yes, this again. Still the complaints come in from local residents and still we see things outside that are deeply concerning. We are in conversations with the local police about possible solutions and we have asked local residents, when they have complained, to inform the police. Among the things we are seeing are:

- Cars parked across driveways
- Cars parked on zigzag lines
- Cars pulling in towards the gates, dropping children off and circling round at times when lots of children are present
- Drivers getting angry with each other, creating distressing scenes for children to witness

It is a deep concern that the chances of a serious accident around school appear to be high. Children as young as 3 come to schools on our site. So do disabled children. Children even younger than that, including babies in prams, come on the school run. Elderly people are here every day. Pets too. Please drive and park legally, safely and considerately.
