- Pasta, rice & noodles •
- Spaghetti hoops
- Tinned meat & fish
- Tinned fruit, rice pudding & custard
- Cereals & biscuits •
- Jam & marmalade
- Toothpaste, soap, shower gel & shampoo
- Toilet rolls & nappies
- Deodorant & sanitary products
