We have some news about the before and after school provision at our school. For some years, this has been run by a private company, namely Beeches Kids and Training (BKT). We have taken the decision to cease this arrangement with BKT and run the provision ourselves with effect from the start of the Spring Term. We are thankful to BKT for running this provision which I know many of you have relied on.

In the coming weeks, we will be consulting with the parents and children that make use of the provision in order to make our plans and ensure that we are providing a service that works for everyone - that is fun and safe for all children, that gives them a good start to the day and something to look forward to at the end of the day. We anticipate that the timings will remain the same and the price will be the same or similar, but we will confirm these details in the coming weeks. We will make clear from the outset that we do aim to run this provision at a modest profit. 100% of any profit made will go into our school budget and will be used to benefit the children.

We will keep you updated as we go along - there is a lot to sort out, but we are very excited to be taking over this provision.
