LAST DAY OF TERM

The Autumn Term finishes on Friday 17th December and there are a few things about that day that you need to know.

CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY

A reminder that Friday 10th December is Christmas Jumper Day. This will be a non-uniform day and children are invited to wear a Christmas jumper if they have one. We are asking for a donation of £2, or whatever you can afford, for Save The Children; please make your donation via School Money.

LOOKED-AFTER CHILDREN

If a child in your care has ever been classified as "looked after" by any Local Authority, it is important that we know about this, even if you believe that it has no impact on their wellbeing, for two main reasons: First, the school receives just under £2000 a year in additional Pupil Premium funding for every looked after or formerly looked after child. This enables us to create extra learning opportunities for these children. Second, it gives your child priority for school places, including for secondary schools. If you believe your child has ever been classified as "looked after" and we may not know about it, please inform the school office.

RAFFLE TICKETS

Raffle tickets will go on sale from Monday after school. We will be on the playground selling tickets. They will be charged at £2 for a strip of five tickets. The raffle will be drawn on Friday 17th December in the morning - the children will be able to watch in their classrooms and will come to the hall to choose a prize if they have won. Our star prize is a brand new bike, kindly donated by Aspire, one of the teaching agencies we work with, and we will have lots of other prizes, including board games and food and drink.

READING VOLUNTEERS

Reading is our biggest learning priority in school and has a massive impact of everyone's life. We are always looking for different ways to increase children's opportunities to read, and it's been a while since we have had parent volunteers in to read with our children. If that's something you feel you might be able to commit to for a period of time, please contact Mr. Wheatley to discuss it further. Ideally, if anyone can come in at 1pm for 20 minutes on any days, that would be a great help, but there may be opportunities at other times too. A new DBS check would be required, but the school would pay the cost of that.
