LAST DAY OF TERM

The Autumn Term finishes on Friday 17th December and there are a few things about that day that you need to know. EXTREME WEATHER

It is very rare that extreme weather will force a school closure. When we do have snow or other extreme weather, occasionally the Local Authority will make the decision to close all Birmingham schools, but usually it is down to the individual schools to assess our own levels of risk. We will always try to find the right balance between jumping too early (there were a few cases some years ago where schools made the decision in the evening to close for the next day, and then all the snow had gone in the morning!) and giving you enough time to put arrangements in place. However, if there is snow forecast, it is always advisable to have a contingency in place, just in case. If we do close, we will send out a text message and put messages on the website and on Twitter. If there is nothing there, please assume we are open. Please do not telephone the office to ask if we are open.

BEECHES BUSY KIDS CLUB

We are very excited to be launching our new before and after school childcare provision after Christmas, and it will be known as **Beeches Busy Kids Club**. This reflects the fact that there will be lots for children to do and enjoy at the club, and they will probably be very busy, but if your child prefers to chill out and relax after a hard day's work, they will have that option too. We understand that some of you will never need to make use of this service, but one thing that we are hoping to be able to offer is a "drop-in" service, where you can book a place at the last minute if your circumstances suddenly change. In order to be able to do that, we would be grateful if you would look at the contract we will be sending out next week, fill it in and send it back to us if there is any possibility you will ever want your child to attend. That way, you will be able to phone us up on a Tuesday afternoon and say, "I'm stuck in a meeting in Basingstoke - can my child go to club tonight please?" As long as there is a space available and you make the payment online, we will be able to do this. If we don't have your completed contract, we won't be able to look after them in club.
