## END OF TERM

The end of term is fast approaching and there are a few things you need to be aware of:

### Year 6 Leavers' Hoodies

We are expecting the hoodies to arrive next week and they will be given out by the end of the week. The children are welcome to wear them to school in place of their school jumper or cardigan from Monday 11th July onwards. Please note, apart from the hoody, they should be wearing school uniform. Children going to Conover will be able to wear their hoodies there.

### Collection of Books and Teacher Chats

On Monday 18th July, straight after school, you are invited to come into school to collect your child's books. Please note that in some cases, where there are lots of unused pages, we will be keeping your child's current books for your child to use in the new term. This is because we want to be kind to the environment and to the school budget! But there will be plenty of books for you to collect. Your child's teacher will be around for you to have a chat to if you wish, although this will have to be brief. ### Last Day of Term

School will be open until 3.20pm as usual, so don't worry if you need your child to stay for the full day - that will be fine. Without the email, we won't be able to let anyone go early without an adult.
