SNOW WHITE

We now have approximately 30 tickets left for our Snow White pantomime next Wednesday. (Oh yes we do!) These are priced at £5 each and are available on a first-come-firstserved basis in the school shop on School Money. Please note we have decided not to send out tickets for this event; if you have booked, we will have your name on a list when you arrive. We have sent a text message to confirm with those that have booked so if you think you have booked and didn't receive a text message, please contact the office.

On the day, we will need you to collect your children at 3.20pm as usual. The doors will reopen at 4.00pm. You are welcome to stay on the playground before school reopens, but we regret that we won't be able to allow you to wait in the school building. We ask that everyone arrives by 4.15pm at the latest so that we can get everyone seated. Children will be able to use their usual toilets. Adults will be able to use the staff toilets on this occasion, but please note that the facilities are very limited in number.

We will have some refreshments and merchandise on sale, including tea and coffee, soft drinks, sweets, candy floss, glow sticks and flashing items. Prices will range from 50p to £2. These will be on sale at the start and during the interval. We estimate the show will finish at about 6.00pm. It's going to be lots of fun and we look forward to seeing you there!
